

Visitor guide

We want to ensure that every visit to the Health Innovation East office is as stress-free and comfortable as possible. We've put together some key guidance to help support your visit.

How to find us

We are located on the south side of Cambridge, just off the A1307 - positioned close to both the Cambridge Biomedical Campus and the Babraham Research Campus.

Please note, some navigation systems may take you to the Gog Magog Golf Club. If you are unsure which exit to take off the roundabout, follow the COVID

testing sign down Hinton Way.

Once you arrive at Magog Court, we are Unit C. Our building is positioned directly behind the large sign with a list of all of the building units and occupants. There will also be a small sign in front of our building that says 'Unit C', 'Health Innovation East'.

Arriving by car

There are plenty of free parking spaces available to anyone visiting the office by car. Please park in the gravelled area surrounding the buildings.

Arriving by bike

As we are located so close to the centre of Cambridge, many of our colleagues and visitors choose to arrive by bike. There are bike stands for you to secure your bike and toilets to change in if you have arrived in cycling gear.

Arriving by train

Cambridge train station is just three miles from the office and buses regularly leave from the station.

We suggest taking a green park and ride bus from Cambridge train station to Babraham Park and Ride which is only a short walk (5-10 minute) from our



office. The Babraham Road Park and Ride services operates every 10 minutes. The bus ride will take approximately 15 minutes to arrive at the Park and Ride.

Other local train stations include Great Shelford and Cambridge North.

Arriving by bus

Babraham Road Park and Ride is just a short walk (5-10 minute) from the office. The bus can be caught from Cambridge town centre and the Grafton Centre. Further details of stops can be found [here](#). The service operates every 10 minutes and will take approximately 15 minutes to arrive at the park and ride.

The 13 bus (from Haverhill to Drummer Street, Cambridge) stops at Cottages, Shelford Bottom, which is a 5 minute walk from our office. The bus can be caught from Botanic Gardens, which is a 6 minute walk from the train station. The journey takes 11 minutes.

Accessing the building

Once you have arrived, please press the buzzer on the right hand side of the door and one of our colleagues will let you in.

If you require step free access, we also have a door round the side of the building. Please press the buzzer at the front of the building and a colleague will show you where to enter.
